HOW TO MAKE YOUR WEDDING UNIQUELY YOURS

Family Heirlooms.

Incorporate heirlooms into your wedding day details. Your family heirlooms are so sentimental and tell stories that are unique to you and cannot be replicated. It's so exciting to peek into a family's history on the wedding day and watch as two families join together and create a new piece of family history.

Your story.

Think about your story, and ways to incorporate bits and pieces into your event. Consider date nights, vacations, and notable events from your time dating, and incorporate them into your plans. For example in lieu of table numbers, you might choose different places you have gone together to identify each table. Offer guests a signature cocktail that is a nod to a location you visited. If it is a significant part of your lives together, there are ways you can incorporate it into your wedding! You just have to think creatively.

Elements of surprise.

Maybe the two of you love to attend local food truck gatherings, so you could have your favorite food truck come for a late night, surprise snack. . Or perhaps you have a surprise during your first dance where you start off slow at first but then switch to a fast paced choreographed song. Just make sure to inform your photographer of any surprises you have planned so they can best prepare.

Use music to tell parts of your story.

Music is so deeply tied to our memories, so having your band play songs that have been a soundtrack to some part of your lives together can be a wonderful way to personalize your reception.

Special details.

Plan to incorporate details that speak to your personalities and stories. When you can look around and see all of the thought that went into each moment of the day, the wedding becomes unique and unforgettable!



UNDERSTANDING THE ROLE OF YOUR WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHER

Sometimes couples decide not to hire a wedding planner or coordinator because their photographer is assisting them with the timing of the day. While your wedding photographer will work with you to plan out your day, as it pertains to scheduling the photo timeline, it's usually best if this is done in conjunction with a coordinator or wedding planner so that your photographer can concentrate on what they do best, documenting your wedding through photography.

Wedding photographers and coordinators work together to ensure that the day runs as smoothly as possible so that you can relax and enjoy yourself. Putting your photographer in touch with your planner or coordinator will allow them to plan out the day ahead of time so that nothing feels rushed or stressful.

Your coordinator is already involved with everything from your makeup to your flowers and décor so it only makes sense for them to work with your photographer to achieve the best possible results. They will be able to tell the photographer when the venue is ready for décor shots and when they should be ready to photograph you getting ready. Working with both a photographer and a coordinator allows you to fully enjoy your wedding day because you will be guided on what to do next and where everyone needs to be.



TIMELINE

for Your Wedding Day



Getting Ready Details

(30-45 min.)

These shots include the dress, bridal party attire, shoes, rings, flowers & other details.



Bride & Groom Prep

(45-60 min.)

The lead shooter will stay with the bride, while a second shooter will stay with the groom.



Bride & Groom Portraits

(30 min.)

After hair and makeup is an optimal time to get the individual shots of the bride and groom.



Sneak Peek or "First Look"

(45-60 min.)

This allows couples time to capture the genuine emotion of seeing each other for the first



Wedding Party Shots

(45-60 min.)

The bride and groom with the bridal party both individually and full group shots are taken at this time.



Family Portraits

(45-60 min.)

Allow approximately 3-5 minutes per family member grouping, though it may not take that long.



Ceremony Venue

(30 min.)

Your photographer needs time to photograph the ceremony venue prior to guests arriving & entering.



Additional Family Portraits

(45-60 min.)

After the ceremony, you can have additional photos taken with your extended family & special guests.



Couples Session

(60 min.)

The couples' session is scheduled 20 min. from sunset because the best lighting occurs then.



Reception Venue

(30 min.)

Allow your photographer can take shots of the reception venue prior to guest arriving & entering.



Sneak Out

(30 min.)

Some couples wait until dinner is served to sneak out to do these shots while guests are eating.

Having a clear and complete schedule for your day will allow us to get the best shots and recognize any problems before they occur. For example, a clear schedule will ensure we know when your toasts are beginning and when we have time to get detail shots of your venue and the setting. It is especially important to make sure you have carved out enough time for formals and romantic shots. Please plan for at least five minutes per pose or grouping. It is always a good idea to have a buffer around each of these types of important times, to account for any transportation issues or just the unexpected.



PRICING

The wedding photography pricing is simple! Just start with the base package and add what you need.

Wedding Photography **\$2900**

The wedding package includes an engagement session, photography timeline planning, 6 hours of wedding photography with one photographer, an online gallery, a personal gallery app, edited digital images and custom printing options.

Add two hours of wedding day photography **\$400**

Add four hours of wedding day photography **\$800**

Add an additional photographer **\$400**

Add a Bridal Session **\$300**

A 20% non-refundable installment will be required to hold your wedding date. Final payment will be due on the week of the wedding.

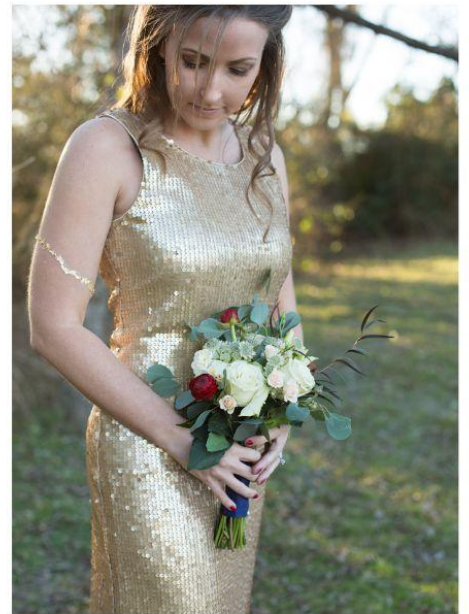




IMPORTANCE OF A WEDDING ALBUM
